



## Say Yes to Education – Guilford County Scholarship

North Carolina A&T State University is one of the Say Yes Guilford County partnering institution. The Say Yes program will provide last dollar tuition scholarships for all eligible graduates of the Guilford County School System to attend North Carolina public colleges, universities, or community colleges. Eligibility for a Say Yes last dollar tuition scholarship is determined after all other federal, state and institutional scholarships and grants are applied to the tuition component of the student's bill.

### Eligibility

- Graduate from the Guilford County Public School System in June 2016 or after.
- Continuous enrollment in a Guilford County Public high school through 12th grade.
- Enroll full-time at a Say Yes to Education Partner College within 15 months of high school graduation.
- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Complete and submit a Say Yes Guilford County Tuition Scholarship Application and all other required documentation of residency and public school attendance.

To be considered for the SAY YES funds, students must complete the Certification Form by following the instructions below:

### Say Yes Certification Form Instructions

1. Go to: <https://sayyestoeducation.escholarshipsolutions.com>
2. Click **Apply Now** (Do not enter anything into Username/Password)
3. Complete the requested information
  - Account Information
  - Contact Information- **Be sure that your email is correct, this will be our primary way of contacting you.**
  - Demographic Information
  - Guardian Information
  - Check the Account Confirmation box
4. Press **Submit Application**

You will receive a confirmation email stating that your Scholarship Certification Form has been received. Once the Say Yes Guilford Scholarship Department has confirmed your account (please allow three-four weeks), you will be sent login credentials with further instructions.
