North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University (A&T) announces a national search for the position of Chancellor. A&T is the largest historically black university in North Carolina and is currently the nation's leading producer of African American engineers with both B.S. and Ph.D. degrees. In the fall of 2008, A&T enrolled 10,388 students from across the United States and 26 foreign countries in 180 academic majors. The University has approximately 1,700 faculty and staff positions. Its annual budget exceeds \$216 million.

As chief executive and administrative officer of the institution, the Chancellor will provide visionary leadership enabling A&T to achieve its strategic goals, develop innovative approaches for expansion of resources and ensure the fiscal and academic vitality of all colleges and schools, subject to the policies established by the University of North Carolina Board of Governors, the North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University Board of Trustees, and the President of the University of North Carolina system.

We seek a highly committed, innovative and collaborative leader who will guide the University at this time of tremendous opportunity. The Chancellor, together with the Board of Trustees, will set the agenda and strategic vision for the future of A&T. He or she will lead by example, enhancing the sense of community and intellectual environment of the University. We are seeking a nationally recognized leader and an education trendsetter, who will strengthen partnerships and relationships within the framework of A&T, the community-at-large, nationally and internationally, while serving as an ambassador for A&T.

The successful candidate should possess a terminal degree; have demonstrated leadership skills in an academic environment; senior experience in the administration of large-scale, diverse, and complex research universities; and a strong scholarly record. He or she will be well-respected, dedicated to preserving and building upon A&T's strong heritage and traditions, while remaining open to innovation and change.
