**SCOPE OF WORK**

The following is a re-advertisement for the NCA&T College of Engineering Audio/Video Up-fit, Campus Address is 1601 East Market Street, Greensboro, North Carolina 27411. The project is located on the Campus of North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University in McNair, Graham and Cherry Halls. The project includes Two Phases, with separate proposals to be provided for each phase. Both phases of work will be required to be complete by August 16, 2013.

The scope of work includes the installation of Audio Video equipment and accompanying software for classrooms, lecture rooms and an auditorium. There is to be a limited scope of electrical and the integration of data to be a part of the work to be performed. The project expeditor (primary contractor) for the work to be performed shall be an Audio/ Video (A/V) vendor. The University's use of Crestron is standardized and the Vendor must be a Crestron certified dealer to bid or perform work for Phase I & Phase II as stated in this document.

In order to meet the required deadline and to expedite the project the University will receive separate proposals for work to include the following to be known as Phase I, which includes Lecture Rooms and an Auditorium in McNair Hall and Graham Hall. Phase II scope of work shall include Classrooms and Lecture Rooms in McNair Hall and Cherry Hall. Phase III scope of work shall include furnishing for the spaces.

In order to expedite the project, no one contractor shall be awarded both Phase I & Phase II of the project scope unless contractor provides separate installation teams to work independently on each project. The University reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.
