

It's Easy and Convenient



Simply complete a pledge form or pledge online (ePledge) during the campaign months of August to November. (Universities run through December 31.)

It's More Powerful



Payroll deductions allow you to make small payments from each paycheck, making it easier to afford a more generous gift.

Quality and Choice



Charities must apply annually and meet stringent eligibility requirements to be included in the campaign.



Volunteers work together to plan and implement the campaign helping keep costs very low.

The 2018 campaign raised \$3,440,574.



Frequently Asked Questions

Who can contribute?

All state employees and retirees are eligible to participate. If you do not have access to payroll deduction you may give by cash, check, credit card, or stock transfer gift.

Are my contributions tax-deductible?

Yes. Keep a copy of your pledge form or print your ePledge confirmation email. You may need additional documentation to support your contribution depending on the amount you pledge. Consult your accountant or tax advisor for more information.

What is the duration of my payroll deduction and when does it begin?

Deductions begin January 2020 and continue through December 2020.

What happens to my contribution if I don't designate a specific charity?

The SECC's rules specify that all undesignated gifts be proportionately distributed to those charities receiving designations. For example, if Charity A receives 5% of designated pledges, then Charity A will also receive 5% of undesignated pledges.

Is there a minimum donation to designate a charity?

Yes. The minimum donation to designate your gift to a charity is \$10. If you donate less, your contribution will be undesignated.

How is my personal information shared?

Only the information you provide (name, email and/or address and amount pledged) is shared with your designated charity or charities. You may remain anonymous (opt-out) by checking the box found on the pledge card or ePledge site.

What is the administration cost of the campaign?

The SECC's low administrative cost (12% of the prior year's campaign) is a lower percentage than most charities spend on fundraising and administrative costs themselves.

Don't see your favorite charity listed?

Try searching online at NCSECC.OYG

If your favorite charity isn't on this year's campaign list, encourage them to apply for the 2020 Campaign.

Application materials for 2020 will be available in November 2019.

Charities can learn more about the application process and requirements under SECC Charities on the SECC website (ncsecc.org).

Your donation to a cause that's important to you is your personal Power of Giving!

Start by asking yourself, "What's important to me?"

Think about people in your life, your hobbies and interests, and things you would like to change or are concerned about.


