Spring 2005:

- North Carolina A & T State University became part of LANGURE Program
- Identified interested Senior Research Fellows—  
Current representatives/fellows are from Animal Science, Chemistry, Biology, Industrial engineering, Plant Science, Energy and Environmental Studies, History/Philosophy, Social welfare/Counseling, and Computer Science.

Fall 2005:

- Create awareness through letters to the Academic deans, department chairs, directors of academic programs, and administrators
- Hosted a one day mini lecture by LANGURE director, Gary Comstock and other program personnel.

Spring 2006:

- Presentation ( on LANGURE) to directors of Graduate programs

- Proposed a course on Introduction to Research Ethics Course (based on LANGURE content)
- Collaboration with School of graduate programs and registrar's office to designate a common # for the course across discipline (#998)
- Developed a one hour credit course in collaboration with Dr. Schimmel, Director, Energy and Environmental Studies Ph.D. Program- (EE700; Intro. To Research Ethics)

Fall 2006:

- Presentation to New graduate students (graduate student Orientation organized by graduate school) on LANGURE and the need for Research Ethics course in their respective programs). This was well received by over 55 students attending.
- Co-teaching (with Dr. Schimmel) EE 700, Introduction to Research Ethics to Energy and Environmental Studies Ph.D. students (17 enrolled). We are using the LANGURE content with modifications for our campus and discipline specific cases.
- Plan to submit new course proposal ( #998, Intro. To Research Ethics) through the Graduate School, to University Faculty Senate Curriculum Committee
- NC A & T LANGURE Senior Research Fellows meeting planned for mid October before the Steering Committee
- **Immediate Future Goals:**
  - **Teach Research Ethics across disciplines by fall semester, 2007**
  - **Develop Research Ethics Center at North Carolina A & T State University**
