

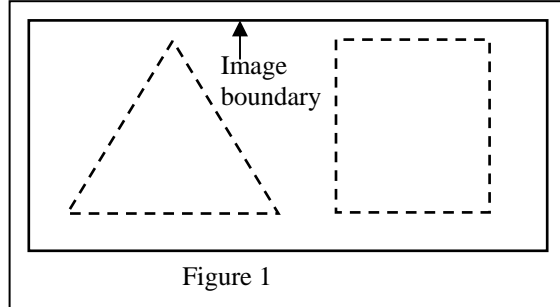
COMP 322 Internet Systems Fall 2007 Assignment 1

Part 1.

Write a Web pager that contains an image with two hotspots, one in the shape of a triangle and one in the shape of a rectangle. Dimension and place the hotspots roughly as shown in Figure 1, but make sure they are big enough to be selected easily. One hotspot loads a page with a list of the days of the week, and the other loads a page with a list of the months of the year. You also write the two pages with these lists. Use any image that you want.



Part 2.

Write a Web page that produces the table shown below. The two cells labeled “Image” should contain images – any images you like. The leftmost two columns should be grouped together and align left. (Use `colgroup`.) The third and fourth column from the left should have “center” alignment. Your browser won’t render your table exactly as shown here. That’s OK. Let your browser do the detail for you; don’t force it.
