**IMPORTANT SUMMER SESSIONS FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION**  
**(FIRST AND/OR SECOND SESSIONS INCLUDING DUAL)**

Read the following: complete and return the attached application. By signing the application, you acknowledge that you have read and understand the following information.

**2009 Summer Sessions Information**

- The deadline for submitting Financial Aid Applications for all summer sessions is **May 15, 2009**.
- Your award will be based on the number of hours enrolled and housing status. Financial aid may be adjusted if your status changes.
- The Summer Session is an extension of the 2008-2009 academic year. Therefore, you must have a processed 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid on file to be considered for summer financial aid.
- Enrollment during the 2008-2009 academic year is a prerequisite for eligibility of aid for the 2009 Summer Session.
- Your financial aid for the 2009 Summer Session(s) will be canceled if you are not maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) at the end of the 2009 Spring semester.
- Your financial aid may be reduced or canceled for the summer session if you drop, never attend or withdraw from courses. It may also require repayment of funds already disbursed during the summer session.
- **Book vouchers are not available for Summer School.** No Federal or State aid will be given for Inter-Session.

**Types of Aid Available**

- During the summer, funds are generally limited to the Federal Direct Loan and the Federal Pell Grant.
- **Federal Pell Grant** – You may be enrolled less than half time to receive the Federal Pell Grant. The Student Financial Aid Office will determine if you have any remaining eligibility for the Federal Pell Grant.
- **Federal Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans** – Your eligibility is based on the amount borrowed during the 2008-2009 academic year. The Student Financial Aid Office will inform you of your eligibility.
- **Federal Direct PLUS Loan** – If you have borrowed the maximum amount on your student loan, your parents may be eligible to borrow through the Federal Direct Plus (Parent) Loan Program. The application process takes approximately 7 – 10 business days. **Apply early.**
- You must complete a Promissory Note for the summer session and a Direct Loan certification form if you did not receive a loan for the 2008-2009 academic year.
- You must enroll at least half time to borrow from the Federal Direct Loan Program. (Undergraduate students must take six (6) hours in the first summer session. Graduate students must be enrolled in five (5) hours of Graduate level courses in order to receive a Federal Direct Student or Parent Loan).
- Direct Loans and Parent Plus Loans are disbursed in two payments, the second of which you will not receive until the midpoint of the summer session. If you are a first time borrower, your loan will not be disbursed until thirty (30) days after the first day of class.
- **Alternative Loan** – You must register for at least 3 hours each session of summer school to receive an Alternative Loan.

**Undergraduate students must enroll for at least six (6) hours in first session and Graduate students at least five (5) hours of graduate level courses (600 and above), to receive consideration for financial aid during the summer. Your loan eligibility will be based on the amount borrowed during the 2008-2009 Fall and Spring semesters. If you have borrowed the maximum loan amount for your class level for the 2008-2009 academic year, you will not be eligible for Direct Loan assistance during the Summer Session. You may apply for an Alternative Loan.**

Your application will be processed according to the information provided on this form. You must notify the Student Financial Aid Office immediately of any changes in your enrollment plans. Any financial assistance you receive is subject to adjustment, cancellation and/or repayment if you fail to enroll as stated on the application.
