Graduate Students Health Care Requirements

The Sebastian Health Center (SHC) welcomes you to the University. A variety of medical and health services is provided for students enrolled in campus courses who pay the health fee. Services are offered to registered students between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12 midnight (Monday-Friday).

The Graduate School provides a variety of programs for educational enhancement. Below are the current immunization requirements for all students prior to registration. Instructions for completing the Medical Health Packet and requirements are available via the web at www.ncat.edu/~health/ in the Immunization and Records section noted as Forms. You may find on the web-site the fee charges for immunizations administered at the Sebastian Health Center for those students who arrive on campus and do not have copies of their vaccination records. Graduate Students are not required to have a physical examination on file. ***You cannot register until you have completed and submitted the Medical Health Packet.***

The following instructions will assist you in your transition to the University and completing NC Immunization requirements:

Distance Learners: The NC Immunization Law does not mandate you to complete any forms. Please contact the Medical Records department about your intent to enroll. Please note that at any time you are considered an on campus student, you will have to meet NC Immunization requirements.

Post Baccalaureate Studies (PBS): Students who take 5 or more hours on campus, before 5:00 p.m. are required to meet the NC Immunization requirements. Please download the Medical Health Packet form located at the above web-site address.

Teacher Certification / Certificate: Students who are considered visitors taking 3 hours or less, attending the University to complete certificate courses, must individually contact the Medical Records office for additional advisement.

Graduate / Doctoral Students:

- Taking 5 hours or more on campus, before 5:00 p.m. cannot register until you have completed and submitted the Medical Health Packet. Please download the Medical Health package from the above web-site address.
- Taking 4 hours or less are required only to send the Medical Health History and Family Health History form back to SHC.
- Students 50 years of age and older taking 5 hours or more on campus have to present proof of the 3 tetanus series with 1 dose lasting through your matriculation at the University. You are also required to complete the contents of the Medical Health Packet.
