

Graduate Certificate in School Administration

North Carolina A&T State University “add-on” certificate for School Administration Licensure program consists of a total of (21) twenty-one course hours which include (9) nine hours of internship experience. The candidate must pass the School Leadership Licensure Assessment. Each candidate must have an earned Master’s Degree in Education from an accredited institution, three years of teaching or professional educator experience.
