### **Rehabilitation of Racial & Ethnic Minorities with Behavioral Addictions (REMBA)**

The purpose of the REMBA Scholarship is to provide additional specialized training to rehabilitation counselors to provide effective culturally competent services to racial and ethnic minorities with varying types of behavioral addictions. Such addictions include, but are not limited to, alcohol and drug abuse, sex addiction, gambling, eating disorders, and criminal offense.

The REMBA Scholarship provides:

(a) tuition and fees (two years and one summer) **summer is contingent upon available funds**

(b) an \$800.00 monthly stipend contingent upon enrollment

(c) a travel allowance to select conferences

\*As a condition for receipt of this scholarship, recipients are required to participate in research activities including but not limited to: assisting in planning and presenting during the annual REMBA conference and submitting a manuscript to a peer review journal for publication prior to graduation (scholars will work with a research mentor).

Students applying for the REMBA Scholarship will be required to complete an additional 12 hours of course work in addictions:

-*Theories and Foundations of Addictions*

-Marriage and Family in Addictions

-*Psychopharmacology*

-Psychopathology

Graduates of the program, who complete these four addictions courses plus a substance abuse counseling internship, will receive a certificate in Rehabilitation Counseling and Behavioral Addictions. Thereafter, students can apply under Criteria C of the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board (NCSAPPB) Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist Process; these applicants have a reduction in NCSAPPB requirements because the Addictions Certification has been pre-approved by the NCSAPPB.
