The faculty roundtable consists of two representatives from each school/college, one elected by the school/college faculty and the other appointed by the Dean of the school/college. This document presents the role of the Faculty roundtable and its current members.

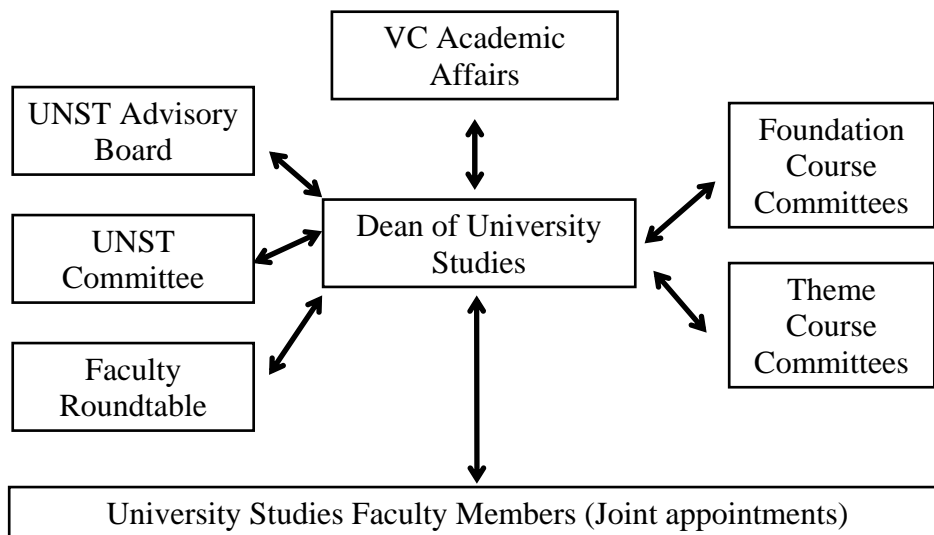


Figure 1: Organizational Structure of University Studies

Role of the Faculty Roundtable

The Faculty Roundtable is the principal academic oversight body for the UNST program. It makes the following recommendations to the Dean of UNST:

1. Certification of courses as belonging to the UNST program. It will carry out this role by evaluating the course description/syllabus against the goals and objectives of the UNST program.
2. Strategies for improving the quality and effectiveness of the UNST program
3. Actions needed to provide responsiveness to the specific requests from the academic schools/colleges.

The Faculty Roundtable will meet once a month according to a published schedule to carry out its business. The Dean of UNST may request additional call-meetings of the Faculty Roundtable, as needed.
