

## General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee Meeting Sep 8, 2004 Minutes

The General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee met on Wednesday Sep 8, 2004 in Dowdy 311 at 10:00 AM. The following were present: Dr. Robert Davis, Dr. Sanjiv Sarin, Dr. Scott Simkins, Dr. Lea Williams.

1. Committee members reviewed the meeting held with instructors of the Fall 2004 pilot courses. It was suggested that more tenured faculty members need to participate in the UNST course development activities.
2. The members next reviewed plans for the Pre-proposal workshop for Spring 2005 pilot courses. The workshop will cover the proposed UNST program learning objectives and curriculum structure, interdisciplinary versus multidisciplinary courses, formative versus summative assessment, and proposed clusters. The workshop will be held on Tuesday Sep 7 (3:00 – 5:00 PM) in Dowdy 304.
3. There was some discussion of the proposed curriculum structure. After some discussion, it was suggested to include the “healthy lifestyles” learning objectives in the Freshman Seminar. It was also agreed to reduce the number of Freshman Proficiency tests from six to four. The proposed curriculum structure will be further discussed at the next full committee meeting.
