

General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee Meeting Sep 22, 2004 Minutes

The General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee met on Wednesday Sep 22, 2004 in Dowdy 311 at 10:00 AM. The following were present: Dr. Robert Davis, Dr. Sanjiv Sarin, Dr. Scott Simkins, Dr. Lea Williams.

1. The Call for Proposals for Spring 2005 Pilot Courses was discussed. The proposed timeline is as follows: Deadline for submission-Oct 1, Feedback to faculty and workshop-Oct 15, 2nd submission-Oct 22, Selection of proposals and notification-Oct 31. Simkins agreed to incorporate suggested changes and distribute it to the Deans/Chairs listserv and to the HR Supervisors listserv. He will also post it on the UNST Website.
2. Davis will discuss budget for the UNST program with Mary Mims.
3. Members discussed the upcoming update to the Provost (Friday Sep 24) and the Cabinet (Monday Sep 27). The general consensus was to keep the presentation short, avoid PowerPoint and minimize handouts.
4. It was suggested that Bob Ussery may be able to help us in getting UNST course prefix set up on the SIS system.
5. Simkins announced that he was close to launching a new Website for UNST.
6. Davis mentioned that the Healthy Lifestyles learning objectives were not yet posted on the Website. Simkins will revise the Preamble/Guiding Principles/Learning Objectives Document with these learning objectives. The learning objectives have been reported in the minutes of the Sep 15 2004 meeting.
7. Lea mentioned that leadership development may be a suitable topic to cover in the proposed new Freshman Seminar class. There was general support for that idea.
