

General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee Meeting Oct 27, 2004 Minutes

The General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee met on Wednesday Oct 27, 2004 in Dowdy 311 at 10:00 AM. The following were present: Dr. Robert Davis, Dr. Sanjiv Sarin, Dr. Scott Simkins, Dr. Lea Williams.

1. Committee members reviewed the presentations at the FUTURES Planning and Resource Council meeting on Oct 20, 2004. The presentations generated considerable discussion from the meeting participants. It was agreed that future course presentations should focus more clearly on learning outcomes and the relationship between course content/pedagogy and university study learning outcomes. The co-chairs will be more explicit with presenters about presentation guidelines in the future.
2. Dr. Nita Dewberry shared information regarding new positions allocated for UNST faculty and requested the committee's help in drafting a job announcement. The executive committee will meet in special sessions on Friday Oct. 29 and on Monday Nov. 1 to prepare this announcement which will be shared with the full committee next week for their input.
3. There was a general discussion of the various ideas that have been suggested for cluster themes. It was agreed that a Town hall meeting would be needed to gather more faculty input. Dr. Lea Williams volunteered to set the Town Hall meetings on Nov 15 and 16 (3-5 PM).
