

General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee Meeting Oct 29, 2004 Minutes

The General Education Core Curriculum Review and Reform Executive Committee met on Wednesday Oct 29, 2004 in Dowdy 311 at 10:00 AM. The following were present: Dr. Robert Davis, Dr. Sanjiv Sarin, Dr. Scott Simkins.

1. Committee members reviewed a draft position announcement for UNST faculty members. After revisions during the forthcoming meeting on Monday, the announcement will be shared with the full committee on Wednesday for comment.
2. Lea Williams has arranged two Town Hall meetings: Monday Nov 15 2005 (New Classroom Auditorium) and Tuesday Nov 16 (McNair Auditorium). Both meetings will be from 3-5 PM and will focus on the proposed curriculum structure and selection of cluster themes for fall 2005. The meeting notice has been disseminated through the HR Listserv.
3. Some key words have been suggested by campus faculty for cluster themes. These and some others generated by committee members are listed here: energy and environment; science and society; preparation for peace; impact of nature, technology and religion on world art; contemporary moral problems; human condition; global experience in modern society; freedom and security; identity in a diverse society; pathways to social justice; meaning of social justice; social justice and the human condition.
