The Environmental Ethics & Philosophy course introduces students to the interdisciplinary nature of ethics and philosophy of waste management and covers the waste management ethics and philosophy of natural sciences, physical sciences, social sciences, humanities, engineering, technology, and economics in an integrated manner. Students are introduced to topics in waste management ethics and philosophy that enhance their critical thinking and problem-solving skills needed in post-academic endeavors.

The advantage of the interdisciplinary Environmental Ethics & Philosophy course is that it signals to employers that students have achieved a specific level of expertise in ETHICS of the environment including work environment and ready to broadly advance that level of expertise in their disciplines.
