

Student Ticketing Regulations

Purpose: Accurately allocate and monitor the distribution of on-campus ticketed events.

REGISTERED NC A&T students are now able to purchase and are eligible to receive a **FREE** ticket for each regular season home basketball and football game on campus, and select student events based on availability online. AGGIE Online Student Ticketing Distribution

Students **MUST** utilize the online ticketing process for football, basketball and select student events. Simply click the **Buy Tickets** (icon/link) in the Quick Links tab of <u>www.ncataggies.com</u> page. You will be redirected to TICKET CENTRAL where you will register your email address with the **Student Activation Link** under MY ACCOUNT. Only use the registration process the first time you activate your online account. You will then be prompted to change your password.

Note: For those that have previously registered your online account you will simply enter your NC A&T email and the password you created. If your account already exists, and you do not remember your password, select the "**Forgot Password**" link.

You must go all the way through the sales process - checkout and submit payment (even if there is no payment due) - until you get to the confirmation page. Once you see the confirmation screen, you have finished your reservation, a mobile ticket or Print-at-Home ticket will be sent to your registered email address. FOOTBALL - After reserving a ticket, print or save ticket to your phone. The student entrance at Aggie Stadium is located at the intersection of Sullivan and Benbow Road and opens 1 1/2 hours prior to kick-off; and 2 hours prior for Homecoming.

BASKETBALL – Students must register for the NCCU vs. A&T Home Game. After reserving a ticket, print or save ticket to your phone. The student entrance is located on Benbow Road side of Corbett Sport Center and opens 1 hour prior to tip-off.

STUDENT EVENTS – Select tickets for events are available online (i.e. Aggie Fest/Homecoming). Reserve tickets as you would for Football and Basketball games.

Please Note: Not all student events are free admission.

Online Student Ticket Allotment and Seating

Student admission to Football and Basketball games are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Student tickets are for general admission seating only.

Basketball vs. NCCU- 2500 free tickets allotted to NC A&T students

Football (Homecoming)- 4000 free tickets allotted to NC A&T students

After student allotments have been distributed, students may purchase a General Admission ticket at a reduced rate.

Select Events (i.e. Aggie Fest/Homecoming) students may or will be allotted up to two (2) tickets at the student price per event.

Improper Sale or Distribution of Student Tickets

Violations of these rules or other student ticketing policies will result in the student being referred to the Dean of Students.

Student tickets are available for eligible NC A&T students only. For students who cannot attend Athletic events you may provide another eligible NC A&T student that ticket, if it is properly transferred, by contacting the Ticket Office. It will be removed from your account and must be registered by the other student, the day prior to the game. The ticket holders AggieOne card must be present with each student ticket for validity. The transfer of tickets for on-campus student events is prohibited.

Students are prohibited from selling any ticket at a price that is higher than the established value of the ticket. Complimentary Student tickets for athletic events are priced at \$0. Ticket prices for select oncampus student events may vary.

Students are prohibited from obtaining student tickets by any means other than the processes that have been set for students.
