MATH 131 and/or MATH 132 can be used as substitutions for either MATH 111 or MATH 112. All MATHs require a minimum of grade C or better. MATH 131 and MATH 132 are recommended for those planning to pursue graduate study. MATH 110 is <u>not</u> a substitute for MATH 111.

²Recommended Scientific Reasoning I List: BIOL 100, CHEM 104/114

Recommended Scientific Reasoning II List (3 credit hour): EASC 201, PHYS 101, PHYS 104, EES 234

³Recommended Courses: HPED 105, 106, 107, 113, 114

⁵This can be any course either inside COBE or external to COBE. ACCT 210 (formerly 203) and ACCT 463 may not be used.

⁶The two (2) courses chosen to fulfill the Humanities elective and the Social and Behavioral Sciences elective must include one African-American Culture and History course and one Global Awareness course (that is, an African-American Culture and History course must be chosen for one of these electives and a Global Awareness course must be chosen for the other elective).
