<sup>1</sup>Two MATHs are required for this discipline: MATH 111 and MATH 112. (MATH 103 & MATH 104 combined can substitute for MATH 111.) MATH 131 and/or MATH 132 can be used as substitutions for either MATH 111 or MATH 112. All MATHs require a minimum of grade C or better. MATH 131 and MATH 132 are recommended for those planning to pursue graduate study. MATH 110 is **not** a substitute for MATH 111.

<sup>2</sup>Recommended Scientific Reasoning I List: BIOL 100, CHEM 104/114

Recommended Scientific Reasoning II List (3 credit hour): EASC 201, PHYS 101, PHYS 104, EES 234

<sup>3</sup>Recommended Courses: HPED 105, 106, 107, 113, 114

<sup>4</sup>Finance Electives: Choose from FIN 369, FIN 464, FIN 465, FIN 552, ACCT 443 or ECON 420.

<sup>5</sup>This can be any course either inside SOBE or external to SOBE. ACCT 203 and ACCT 463 may not be used.

<sup>6</sup>The two (2) courses chosen to fulfill the Humanities elective and the Social and Behavioral Sciences elective must include one African-American Culture and History course and one Global Awareness course (that is, an African-American Culture and History course must be chosen for one of these electives and a Global Awareness course must be chosen for the other elective).
