ISE Scholarship Application

New Student Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to new freshmen and transfer students only. Students completing this application should not submit an application for a research assistant position or vice versa. New student scholarship amounts can range from \$800 to \$2000 for the academic year, and are payable in two equal installments (half for the fall 2017 and half for the spring 2018 semester; see stipulations for continuing eligibility criteria).

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be considered for an ISE New Student (freshman or transfer student) Scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

1. The applicant must be admitted into the Industrial and Systems Engineering major (0104) prior to submitting an ISE Scholarship Application.
2. The applicant must be a full time new freshman or transfer student.
3. The applicant must have a cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 (weighted) or higher; transfer students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
4. The applicant must have a SAT/ACT Math score of 490 / 19 or higher.
5. The applicant must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
6. The applicant must provide 2 letters of recommendations from a non-family member.
7. The applicant should have a need for this scholarship.

Professional standards are encouraged in completing all application materials.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE CRITERIA WILL AUTOMATICALLY RESULT IN YOUR APPLICATION BEING DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Continuing Eligibility Criteria:

1. The applicant must be a full time new freshman or transfer student for the fall 2017 semester.
2. The applicant must have earned 14 credit hours or more at the end of the fall 2017 semester.
3. The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at the end of the fall 2017 semester.

Award Stipulations:

- This award is need based and may affect other aid as deemed necessary by the Office of Financial Aid (check with your financial aid counselor for details).
- Recipient's refund must not exceed cost of tuition and fees unless an off-campus student.

Application Deadline:

Priority Submission Period

First priority will be given to applications received from January 1, 2017 thru March 31, 2017.

Otherwise, completed Applications for the Fall 2017 Semester Must Be received by: **May 31, 2017.**
