Explain why you are a strong candidate for study abroad, referring to your educational achievements, intellectual and personal interests, and career goals.

Your experience abroad will expose you to an academic system, culture, society and (possibly) economic conditions that are different from those of your home country. Reflect on some of the differences you expect to encounter and on what you hope to learn from them.

- 2. A TOEFL score of **195/550** for undergraduate-level status and **213/550** for graduate-level status, OR a Cambridge First Certificate in English grade of 'C' for undergraduate-level status, is required before participating in this program.
- Students requesting on-campus housing will be required to sign a contract with NCA&TSU Office of Housing and Residence Life upon arrival in the U.S. and will be responsible for payment of the room and boarding fees for the full period of the exchange.
- 4. To meet U.S. Immigration and Naturalization visa requirements, visiting students must be registered for at least 12 undergraduate or 9 graduate credit hours per semester.

EXCHANGE STUDENT FINANCIAL GUARANTEE

Financial Requirements: Federal regulations require that North Carolina A&T State University have documentary evidence on file that a nonimmigrant student has adequate financial means to pay all tuition, required fees, insurance (*health, repatriation and medical evacuation*) and living expenses during the approved period of study at the University. Insurance is MANDATORY through the University and has now been set as a "required fee". Exceptions must be reviewed and approved by the ISSO **prior** to submitting a request to waive University insurance.

Exchange students must show adequate proof of funds outside those covered by the respective "Exchange Program Partner". Generally, all tuition and required fees are covered by the program and exchange students need to show the following either by supporting bank documents and/or a bank letter. The <u>original documents</u> should be provided to the U.S. Embassy/Consulate where the exchange student is taking the interview. *Copies can be provided to the ISSO for issuance of DS-2019.*

Please note that the University of North Carolina System requires enrollment in the Mandatory Insurance plan which includes health, repatriation and evacuation. The limits of coverage meet and/or exceed the requirements set forth by the Department of State for Exchange Students. The cost of this coverage is approximately \$709.00 per semester or \$1418.00 per year.

New students will need a one-time "Settling-in" allowance of at least **\$1200** (USD) <u>if</u> they are not living on campus. Apartments and other housing options in the United States generally require deposits and there are other costs associated with establishing utility services (electricity, water, gas, telephone, etc.) as well.

<u>Students Living On Campus</u> – The residence halls are closed during the following breaks: Thanksgiving Holidays (4 days), Christmas/New Year's Break (2 ½ weeks), Spring Break (7 days), and Summer break (3 months). Students must move off campus during the breaks at their own expense. On campus housing during the summer is provided for students attending Summer School only. There are two six-week sessions during the summer.
