The College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences' (CAHSS) Scholarship is to help offset the student's financial obligations. It is not a full scholarship that covers all tuition and fees. The amounts may vary according to available funding and the evaluation of the application package meeting the specified criteria. The scholarship is awarded by semester, and the qualified student may apply each semester. An award one semester does not guarantee a future award, and the application is valid only for the semester submitted.

Criteria for consideration: Full-time sophomore or higher CAHSS major in good academic standing, a minimum of 30 credit hours earned at A&T; minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50, and a complete application package.

A complete application package includes 1) the official applicant information form, 2) a well-written essay, 3) a video essay, and 4) a current resume. All written parts are to be typed in 12-point, Times New Roman or Arial font. No application will be considered if all elements are not in the specified format, assessable by the committee and included in the same email by the deadline.

Email all application materials to cAHSSgeneral@ncat.edu with the subject heading, "CAHSS Scholarship Application Consideration" from your A&T email address. All correspondence will be sent to your A&T email address. You will receive an email confirmation that the package has been received, and confirmation that all files are accessible. Please read the email and respond accordingly if you need to provide additional materials. You will receive an email with the decision of the committee. Do not alter this form.

The essay is typed in 12-point, Times New Roman or Arial font. Please save the file as a Word document or a PDF. No Google Documents or other formats or digital files that are not assessable by the committee will be accepted.

Please respond to the following prompt (500-600 words maximum). "Describe a challenge you have faced in your academic, personal, or community life. How did you address it, and what did you learn from the experience? How has this shaped your goals for the future, and how will this scholarship help you achieve them?"

Part 3 – Video Essay

The student must also submit a 1-to-2-minute video addressing the prompt below. The video may be recorded on your phone and should be a headshot of you answering the prompt. The video file is attached to the email in a common video file that is accessible to the committee without special software or a You Tube link is provided below.

Video Prompt: "Receiving this scholarship is more than just financial support, it's a step toward your future. In a 2–3-minute video, share how this scholarship will have an impact on your life. What does it mean to you personally, academically, and professionally? How will it help you achieve your goals, and how do you plan to give back or pay it forward in your community or field?"

Attach a PDF file of your current resume to the email. The Office of Career Services offers resume writing workshops and will review your resume.
