What is a Poet Laureate?

A poet laureate could be thought of as an ambassador of poetry, raising the consciousness of the community to poetry and its value both written and spoken. During the tenure, the Aggie Poet Laureate will write poems for special occasions such as graduation, give public readings, and initiate projects to help promote poetry awareness and literacy. The poet laureate will serve a term of one year. The United States has a poet laureate, as do many states. The candidates will undergo a rigorous vetting process as determined by the Aggie Poet Laureate Selection Committee. The committee will be comprised of professional writers and library staff. Criteria:

- Any A&T student in good academic standing is eligible to apply and serve, regardless of major.
- All applications <u>must</u> include a writing sample and performance sample.
- All submissions must be received by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>April 22</u>, <u>2025</u> to be considered.
