

Q. How do I get access to the WebFOCUS reporting system?

A. Listed below are the steps required to gain access to WebFOCUS:

- 1) *Prospective users must complete a WebFOCUS User Account Request form.*

- 2) Click on the area form link required and print a copy of the form.
- 3) Complete a User Account Request Form for each area required and forward the form(s) to the appropriate WebFOCUS Domain Administrator.

WebFOCUS Account Request Review Process

The WebFOCUS Domain Administrator reviews each User Account Request form to determine the appropriate level of user access. If the request is approved, the WebFOCUS Domain Administrator completes an Account Privileges form to grant user access for a specific domain and group. The WebFOCUS Domain Administrator forwards the forms to the WebFOCUS Administrator.

The WebFOCUS Administrator creates the user account as directed by the WebFOCUS Domain Administrator. The WebFOCUS Administrator supplies the user with a valid User ID and Password.

All requests for access to student data are governed by the Federal Educational Family Rights and Privacy Act (aka FERPA).
