

Clinical Faculty, Elementary Education: Science (K-8)

Position Overview

The faculty of the Department of Curriculum and Instruction in the School of Education at North Carolina A&T State University invites applications for a full-time clinical faculty position in Elementary or Middle Grades Education (K-8) with a science education focus. The successful candidate will teach courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels; advise students; supervise students during field experiences; collaborate with colleagues in the College of Arts and Sciences, School of Technology, and College of Engineering; play an active role in developing and implementing courses, assessing and evaluating program progress, and restructuring curricula based on societal or student need.

Minimum Qualifications (Required)

Applicants must have an earned doctoral degree from an accredited institution in the area of science education, curriculum and instruction, elementary education, or a related field. Applicant must have a demonstrated record of achievement and creativity in teaching at the elementary and/or middle grades level as evidenced by principal annual evaluations. The applicant must have a commitment to distance education. The applicant must meet university criteria for appointment to the rank of Clinical Faculty, and the applicant must have the ability to communicate effectively to an ethnically, linguistically, and culturally diverse campus community, possess strong interpersonal skills, and have the ability to collaborate with colleagues orally and in writing in an interdisciplinary environment.

Preferred Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will have:

- At least 3 years of K-8 teaching experience
- Preparation in and/or experience teaching K-8 elementary or middle grades courses with an emphasis on science education
- A current teaching license—initial or advanced—in the state of North Carolina
- Evidence of ability to use technology as it applies to K-8 Elementary Education
- Preparation in and/or experience teaching at the university level
- A record of professional and public service
- Knowledge of diversity and urban education issues

Application Process

Applicants must (1) submit an application, (2) submit a letter of interest addressing the qualifications in the position announcement, (3) a curriculum vitae, (4) official transcripts from the institutions granting the Bachelor, Master, and Doctoral degrees, and (5) three professional letters of reference.
