Scholarship Application

Scholarship Eligibility

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible for scholarships offered by the College of Education:

- United States Citizen, Permanent Resident, or hold a current visa
- Full-time undergraduate student (enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours)
- Part-time or full-time graduate student (if applicable for certain scholarships)
- Minimum grade point average of 2.80 for undergraduate students; minimum grade point average of 3.00 for graduate students

Application and Deadline

A completed application packet must include the following items:

- A completed scholarship application
- Three (3) reference forms signed by each recommender
- Interview with faculty panel (undergraduate only for certain scholarships)
- A 500-word essay that addresses the topic: “What difference will I make in the lives of youth as a classroom educator who prescribes to equity, access, and advocacy?”

The deadline for the completed application packet is October 1st for spring semester enrollment or April 1st for fall semester enrollment. For scholarships that require interviews, applicants will be contacted one week after the application deadline to schedule the inquiry process.
