RE: Parking Changes for 2016-2017

Parking and Transportation Services wants to encourage a safe and pleasant parking experience on North Carolina A&T State University's campus. The University has adopted a parking program to create an orderly traffic flow and equitable parking conditions. Your safety is very important to us.

As you bring your vehicle to camps this Fall, please note the following will be enforced beginning September 1, 2016:

- All parking Rules and Regulation will be enforced 7:30 AM – 8:00 PM Monday through Friday
- Any vehicles on property owned, leased or operated by the University require a valid NC A&T parking permit and the vehicle must be registered to the respective permit
- All visitors, guest and vendors must display a valid NC A&T parking permit or utilize the parking deck and paid metered spaces. Permits may be purchased by departments or individuals

Student Parking:

- A new parking permit look is here! All student parking decals (stickers) have been replaced by a hangtag. Please note that all hangtags must be displayed using the rearview mirror of the vehicle **registered to that permit**
- Residential and Commuter Student Permits have been replaced by a single "Student Permit"
- All Annual Student Permits will be effective August 1, 2016 through May 21, 2017
- Effective Fall 2016, students are able to purchase a Student Permit by semester
 - Fall Semester permits are effective August 1 – December 21, 2016
 - Spring Semester permits are effective January 1 – May 21, 2017
- Evening permits are available online
- Summer Permits will be available for purchase Spring 2017

Faculty/Staff Parking

- Faculty/Staff permits are Effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017
- Reserved and General Parking Deck Permits may only be used in the Obermeyer Parking Deck at all times
- Reserved Surface Permits may only be used in the corresponding numbered space
Exception to this policy are for university parking areas outside of NC A&T main campus (i.e. 1020 Wendover, Yanceyville Center)

Parking and Transportation Services will continue to work diligently to develop strategic goals to enhance the parking experience for the NC A&T Community.
