The name of the project is NCA&T Williams Dining Hall, Student Dining, Serving Lines Up-fit; Campus Address is 1601 East Market Street, Greensboro, North Carolina 27411. The project is located on the Campus of North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University in the Williams Dining Hall. The scope of work for this portion includes, but is not limited to, demolition of existing millwork and countertops, limited wall construction and limited tile installation, reinstallation of new millwork and countertops within the serving lines located at the stations within the Student Dining Area. In addition, there will be modification to the existing plumbing and electrical to accommodate the new millwork. The mechanical work is limited to the relocation and installation of a new exhaust hood and modification to an existing exhaust hood. The construction shall be coordinated with the installation of food equipment to be provided by the University under separate contract. It shall be the responsibility of the general contractor and their subcontractors to work in coordination with the food equipment supplier for the installation of the proposed work. This work is to be performed during the summer break and is to be complete and ready for use by mid August 2013.

There will be a Mandatory Pre-bid Conference held on May 21, 2013 at 10:00 am. The location of the Pre-bid Conference shall be in the Conference Room of the DeHugley Building located at 1502 North Benbow Street, Greensboro, NC 274011. Drawings will be released at the Pre-bid Conference. The Project Documents will be provided in electronic format with no deposit required by the Designer upon request by an interested contractor.
